Indemnity Requirements

The owner of any horse which shall, during the time it is on the Show premises, cause or occasion any damage or injury whatsoever, shall indemnify and hold harmless the SBA from and against all actions or claims, and repair any damage or injury which may so be occasioned, and shall be responsible for any injury or damage occasioned by or to the Servant or Servants in attendance of such animal.

Please note that there is free admittance to the driver of the horsebox and 1 passenger. All other passengers must pay admittance fee.

19. Ecobale Young Handler 12 years and over up to 18 years on Show Day
20. Ridden Heavy Horse. These will be judged on performance, manners, and obedience as a riding horse. Flights must be removed or laid down. Hard hats must be worn at all times when riding and be up to current British Standard.
